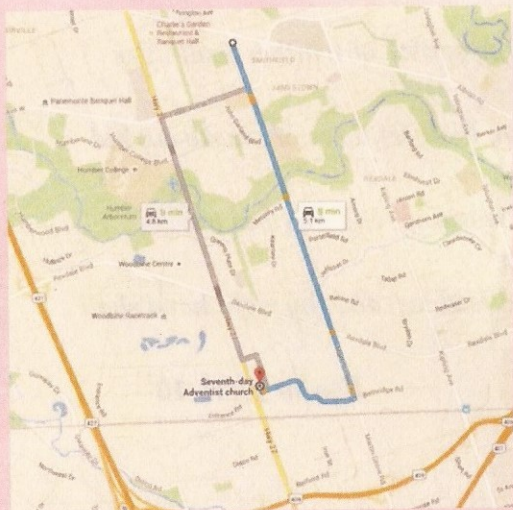

## Mrs. Viola Adassa Morgan

Born September 26, 1935 in Kitson Town, Saint Catherine, Jamaica, to Maltimore Gordon and Maude Facey.

Viola emigrated to England in 1955 to join her sweetheart Milton Kenneth Morgan. They were married a year later in London England. In the summer of 1968 Viola, with her young family, once again followed her husband overseas, this time to Toronto Canada where the family eventually settled.

Diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis in 1980, the disease, along with related complications, slowly and painfully destroyed Viola's joints; arthritis did not however destroy her spirit. Throughout the years Viola took care of her family with selfless dedication, her disability took a back seat to her accomplishments. Viola loved to cook, she gardened, and for a time she also sewed and knitted all her children's sweaters, Viola never forgot those less fortunate and with her husband gave often to those in need.

Baptized at West Toronto Seventh-Day Adventist Church formerly on Harvie Avenue, she looked forward to going to church every Sabbath.

Viola died quietly at home on Thursday, January 14, 2016 with her family by her side.
