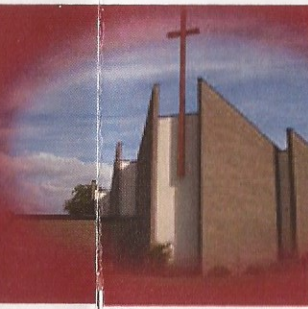

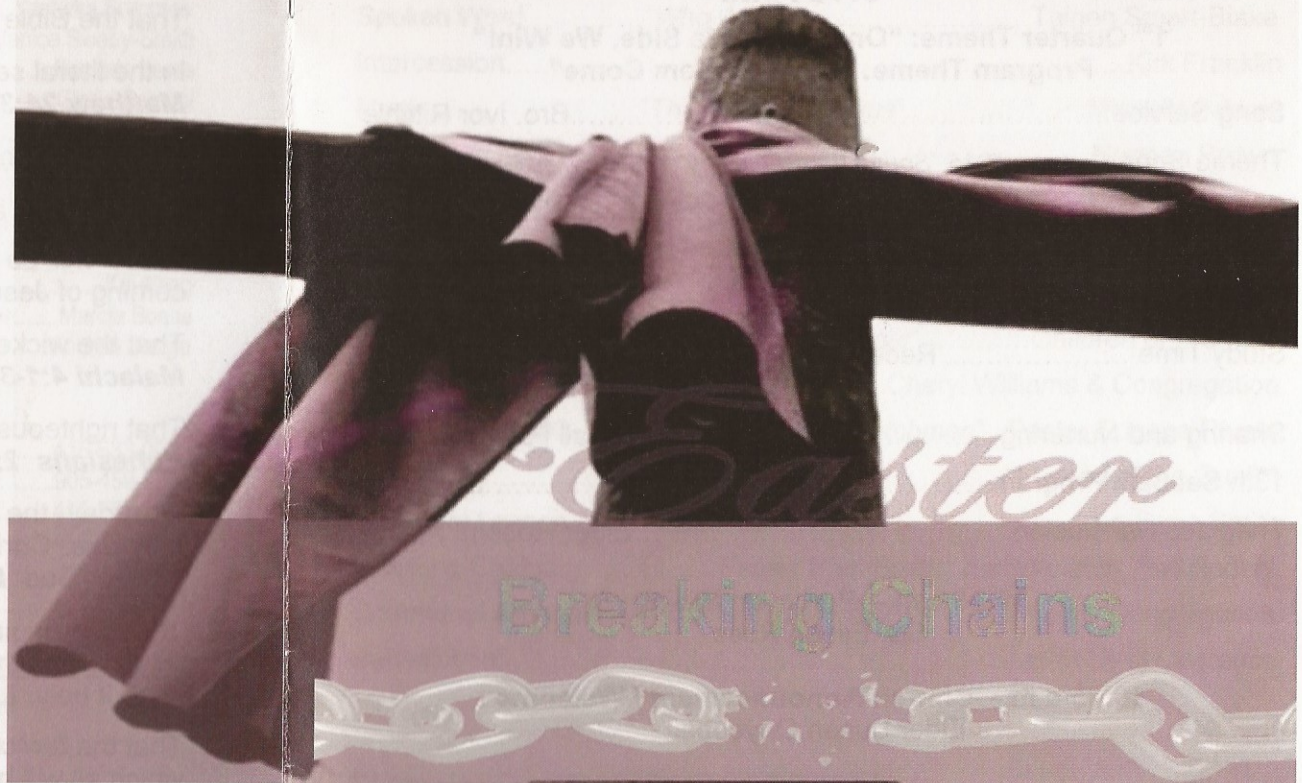

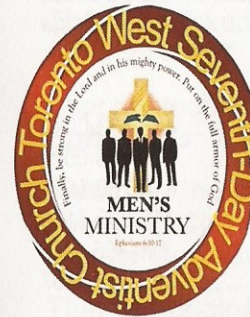

BREAKING CHAINS Pastor Paul Smith, Just Worship, Pathfinders

(As soon as Scriptural Lesson ends, music for "Break Every Chain" starts. 6 Pathfinders enter up centre aisle with cross on shoulders, like coffin, and position it upright, leaning against the baptistery, centre. Rhonelle & Just Worship will be singing. Other pathfinders enter into position. Meanwhile, Pastor Smith walks up Centre aisle, in chains, then . . .then on to stage. By this time, Pathfinders should have encircled the congregation, signing and singing. When appeal is made and congregants move to altar, Pathfinders move in and encircle them. Exit at end of the prayer.)
