## STEWARDSHIP FEATURE "Managing Your Finances"

*"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth" 3 John 2*

### YOU AND YOUR MONEY PART 1 - GREAT FINANCIAL ADVICE

**"No matter how much or how little you make, always save a little bit."** - Whatever money comes into your life, you can (and should) be setting aside some of it. However, remember to return the Lord's tithes and a faithful offering first. The return of the tithe is the duty of all mankind.

**"Know the difference between needs and wants."** - When you can't distinguish between real needs and mere wants, you're constantly talking yourself into spending too much. E.g. "You *need* food. You *want* to go dining at a fine restaurant."

**"Think of the true cost."** - Many things you want to buy involves a number of costs. The price tag is just the start. What about the accent to go with it, the right place to put it, how much it will end up costing, with interest, etc.

**"Buy quality."** - You actually save money by buying things of higher quality that last than by getting cheap stuff you have to throw away in no time."

**"If your outgo exceeds your income, your upkeep will be your downfall."** - It's another way of saying, "Live within your means," or, more elaborately, "Be careful of adding new expenses to the ones you've already got."

**"Don't pay interest on anything that loses value."** - avoid credit card debt and borrow only to buy property or other assets that will appreciate in value.

**"Don't co-sign a loan."** - Co-signing puts your good credit in the hands of someone else -- who could ruin it with a single late payment. If you can't afford to give the money, you can't afford to pay the loan back, should you have to do so.

**"If you need more money, then go out and make more money— or get your money working for you."** Yet be careful not to compromise the other resources of time and the body in doing so.
